

- HUNTING RULES

- **Hunting is subordinate to the conservation of nature and only one method of sustainable utilization. It is important not to damage the environment and to always interact sensitively with nature. Therefore, it can be enjoyed but accuracy in your shooting must always enjoy the highest priority.**
- No hunting will be permitted unless or until a hunter signs and executes this Waiver of Liability and Indemnity.
- Hunting will only be permitted from 07:00 – 17:00.
- **Hunter undertakes to declare all shots**
- Prior to the hunt a few shots must be fired at the designated shooting range to ensure that the rifle/telescope combination are set correctly and also to determine whether the hunter is a competent shot. Only legal registered rifles will be allowed to hunt with.
- Minimum calibre of .243 is allowed for hunting.
- Minimum draw weight of bow is 50 pounds.
- Know the capability of your competence and equipment.
- Do NOT attempt to shoot an animal that is outside of your ability and equipment specifications.
- **Accredited shooting range available on site; all rifles to be sighted before hunting (100m)**
- Ensure your weapons are safe at all times.
- Strictly no rifle hunting is allowed within 400 meters of camp & 200 meters from a vehicle.
- No hunter will be allowed to hunt under the influence of alcohol.
- The decision will remain under the discretion of Management.
- Carcasses will be kept whole. Processing available on request.
- Horn length is determined after the hunt and is final and binding.
- Trophies are measured according to Roland Ward standards.
- The owner has the right to stop a hunt at any time due to alcohol abuse, dispute regarding prices, payments, wounded animals or any inappropriate behaviour.
- During all hunting activities hunters shall be accompanied and be supervised by a Field guide (Veldgids). No Hunters will be permitted to hunt without being accompanied by a Field Guide (Veldgids)
- Any game shot at, and not located, a miss shot will be charged.
- Any Wounded Animals - Intended or Accidental – are payable at full tariff. NO EXCEPTIONS
- If dead or wounded animal are located during your stay or after departure, the hunter will be liable to settle the account according to the price listed.
- In the unfortunate event that an animal has been wounded, all hunting will be put on hold until the wounded animal has been located or for a maximum for 2 hours. it will be the responsibility of the Hunter concerned with the assistance of the Field Guides (Veldgids) to locate the wounded animal. While every reasonable effort will be made to locate a wounded animal, it is managements discretion as to when to return to the hunt.
- The Hunter concerned shall not be permitted to continue with hunting activities until a wounded animal has been located or until the owners of Omulu Safaris decides that a wounded animal cannot be located despite all reasonable efforts to locate such animal. The owner has the right to withdraw hunters, observers, and guides at any time and/or halt hunting activities until wounded animals have been tracked down.

- The use of alcohol during hunting is strictly prohibited and no persons under the influence of alcohol will be permitted to use a weapon or drive a vehicle.
- Only the hunter, and NOT the guide of Omulu Safaris, is responsible for the size, sex and hunt ability of the game he hunts. The hunter must therefore take care to only shoot game he intended to hunt.
- Trophy Fees will apply to all male species.
- Sub-adult animals are payable at full tariffs.
- Female species are payable at full tariffs
- Gestating female animals will be charged at 200% of the normal rate.
- Females may only be hunted during peak hunting season (1 May–31 Aug)
- Do not shoot over border lines
- Only game species specified in the hunting list as provided may be hunted. No rounds may be fired at any plants, trees or other animal or bird not specified in the hunting list provided. A penalty equal to three times the replacement value of the animal shall be payable.
- A parent and a guide must accompany children under the age of 18
- Hunters are to refrain from littering. All cartridge shells, paper and other litter should be collected and discarded at the lodge.
- Hunters will be dropped off and collected from their hunting spots. Hunting from vehicle or if any game is wounded and we need to search for it by vehicle, or any additional driving needs to be done a fee will be charged to your account.

RIFLES

- Hunters are not permitted to hunt antelope bigger than Impala with ammunition loads smaller than 168 grain.
- Hunting with a calibre rifle smaller than .243 is not permitted, unless arranged with the owner.
- Rifle choice is your own preference although we recommend calibres from .270 to 300 Win Mag, for plains game. We recommend you bring the best available ammunition such as Barnes, Nosler partitions, and Swift A-Frame. These are our first choice for soft points among others and have proven themselves over and over in the bush. Loaded 130-180 gr.
- When hunting **dangerous game**, a minimum requirement is a 375 magnum, with recommended ammunition 300gr soft nose and 300gr solids.
- We recommend 60 rounds of ammunition for each calibre for your safari. Shooting distance will range from 100-250 yards.
- **We also cater for the rental of our own Rifles and ammunition to avoid hassles at Airports.**
- You will also get the opportunity to sight in your rifle on a range prior to the Safari. This is always recommended after a weapon has been transported for long distances. Suitable rifle ranges with solid shooting benches are available.
- Prior to your departure from home be sure to practice with your chosen firearms so you are at ease with their features and operation. We suggest your plains game rifle to be sighted in two to two and a half inches high at one hundred yards - this will in effect enable you to comfortably take shots out to 250 yards without having to compensate for distance. A scope is also highly recommended. (i.e. 3-12-42).
