

WHAT TO PACK

FOR THE WEEKEND (Self Catering option)

- Food & Spices
- Beverages
- Towels (bathing and swimming)
- Swimwear
- Insect repellent
- Binoculars
- Warm clothes or Jacket (winter evenings)
- Bicycles & games for kids (optional)

FOR THE HUNT

- Raincoat
- Odourless sunscreen with a minimum SPF of 20
- A good hat
- Hunting clothes, khaki or camo
- A thick jacket, as it gets cold during winter evenings
- Gloves, and possibly a small scarf/buff
- Well-worn and comfortable walking boots with thick socks
- Personal medication
- A good camera and enough film / memory sticks
- Camcorders are welcome and remember battery recharge equipment
- Rifle and cleaning equipment (no semi-automatic rifles are allowed into the country)
- Ammunition (100 per calibre is allowed)
- If you are so inclined to keep a diary of your hunting exploits, bring it along
- If hunting during our summer months (September – April), insect repellent is advised
- We make use of 220 V electrical power supply so, if necessary, please remember your power converter
